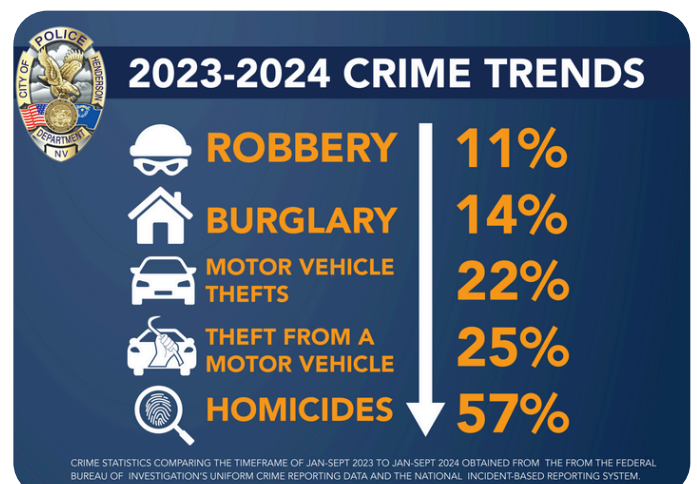


HENDERSON HAPPENINGS APP IS HERE

Ward 2 Updates

VIA INSPIRADA & VOLUNTEER COMMERCIAL

A 950 square-foot restaurant with a drive-through facility for Dutch Bros. and a 2,325 square-foot restaurant with drive through facility for Chipotle is coming to the SE corner of Via Inspirada & Volunteer Blvd. situated on 1.4 acres of land.

CENTURION MIXED-USE

The project includes 80,000 square feet of diverse commercial retail space and two 6-story multifamily buildings for approximately 600 residential units. The commercial portion will be developed in the first phase of the project followed by the multifamily buildings in the second phase. This will take place on the NW corner of Via Inspirada and Via Centro on 24 acres of land within Inspirada Town Center.

VIA INSPIRADA RETAIL CENTER

The project includes a commercial center consisting of a medical office, emergency health care facility, convenience store, gas station, two restaurants, and a restaurant with drive-through facility. This will be placed on the SW corner of Via Inspirada and Bicentennial Pkwy. on 4.8 acres of land.

ALDI

Community Development has received a proposal to remodel the existing Albertson's grocery store building into an ALDI store. The applicant is working with staff to finalize exterior modifications. This will take place on the corner of Eastern Ave. and Horizon Ridge Pkwy.

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
