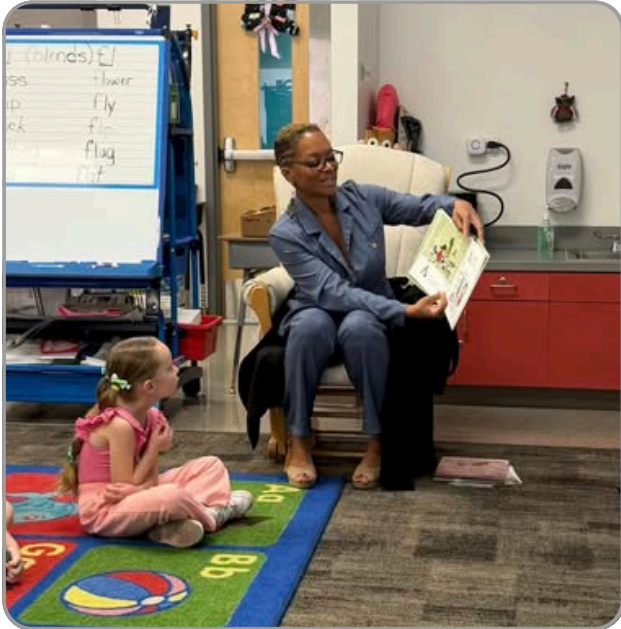
WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH BREAKFAST

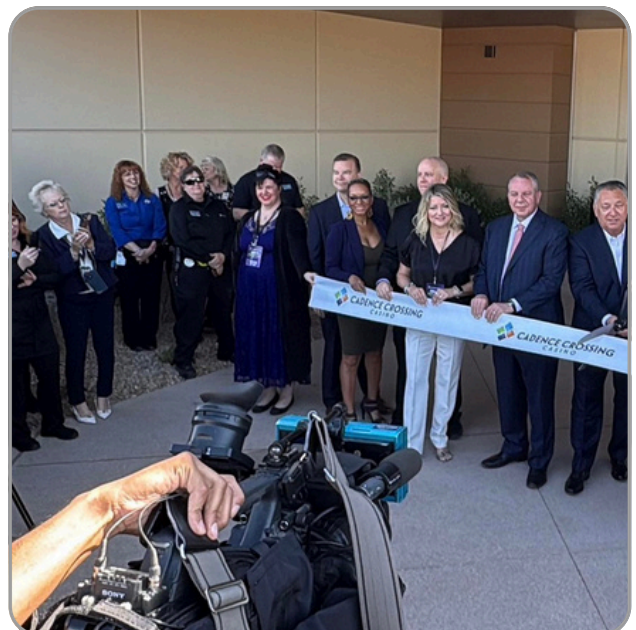
PI PI ZETA EVENT
